



PRINTMAKING FROM NATURE

Friday 14 – Sunday 16 July 2017

Join Sandra Morris (wildlife author/illustrator) for a weekend of nature sketching and printmaking at the Pūkoro Mirānda Shorebird Centre, Firth of Thames.

Learn how to draw and print from the natural world around the Shorebird centre and local shellbanks.

During this workshop you will work with specific drawing exercises to get up to speed to later venture down to the shellbanks and with the use of telescopes visually record in your journals the feeding wading birds as they come in on the high tide to roost on the shellbanks, or you may wish to record the plants that share this amazing habitat.

Using your sketches and photos of birds and plants etc as reference you will turn your images into wonderful prints using a simple lino block printmaking method.

Join us on Friday evening for a light meal and an introduction and night of browsing through Sandra's extensive library of natural history books and nature journals .

We may even have time for some inspiring documentaries.
